Intent

The music curriculum has been sequenced in such a way that it allows students to gradually develop their understanding of music theory, to develop their music analysis skills and increase their skill and confidence across a number of instruments.

Access Key Stage 3 students will explore music from different countries, cultures and time periods whilst developing a strong understanding of the interrelated elements of music which are common across many different cultures and styles.

In Key Stage 4 students will focus their performance practice on one specific instrument, furthering their music analysis skills and composing music in specific styles.

Music brings together people from all cultures and backgrounds, giving them a common language for expressing themselves. At The Grange Academy we strive to support all children in their musical development.
