

Sixth Form Uniform Code

Members of The Grange Academy Sixth Form are expected to wear a professional standard of dress. Students **must** dress in business or office attire. Clothes must be smart, modest and safe, and students must avoid displaying extremes of fashion.

Students are required to adhere to the following guidelines:

Item	Requirement/s
Suit or Tailored	To be worn at all times
Jacket	
Shirt	Top button always to be done up
	Shirt always to be tucked into skirt or trousers
Blouse/Top	Shoulders must be covered
	Not tight-fitting
Tie	Knot to be pulled tight covering the top button on the shirt
	Tie must be worn long enough to reach to the top of the trouser or skirt
Skirt/Dress	To be worn at knee-length
	Must not be tightly-fitted
Trousers	Tailored, full-length trousers
Shoes	Formal shoes
	No trainers or canvas shoes
	No casual boots
Jumpers and	• Smart, thin jumpers or cardigans can be worn under the blazer for warmth
Cardigans	if needed but must not be worn in place of a blazer.
Coats	Coats must not be worn whilst in the Academy building
Unacceptable	Denim of any kind, sports clothing, baggy jumpers, leggings or hoodies are

Hair, Jewellery	Jewellery and make-up may be used but only to the extent that it does not
and Piercings	detract from the dress code or the image of the Academy

Academy ID	Student ID cards must be worn and visible at all times during the academy
