



Sixth Form Uniform Code

Members of The Grange Academy Sixth Form are expected to wear a professional standard of dress. Students **must** dress in business or office attire. Clothes must be smart, modest and safe, and students must avoid displaying extremes of fashion.

Students are required to adhere to the following guidelines:

Item	Requirement/s
Suit or Tailored Jacket	<ul style="list-style-type: none">To be worn at all times
Shirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Top button always to be done upShirt always to be tucked into skirt or trousers
Blouse/Top	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Shoulders must be coveredNot tight-fitting
Tie	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Knot to be pulled tight covering the top button on the shirtTie must be worn long enough to reach to the top of the trouser or skirt
Skirt/Dress	<ul style="list-style-type: none">To be worn at knee-lengthMust not be tightly-fitted
Trousers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Tailored, full-length trousers
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Formal shoesNo trainers or canvas shoesNo casual boots
Jumpers and Cardigans	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Smart, thin jumpers or cardigans can be worn under the blazer for warmth if needed but must not be worn in place of a blazer.
Coats	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Coats must not be worn whilst in the Academy building
Unacceptable Clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Denim of any kind, sports clothing, baggy jumpers, leggings or hoodies are not acceptable.
Hair, Jewellery and Piercings	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Jewellery and make-up may be used but only to the extent that it does not detract from the dress code or the image of the AcademyExcessive hairstyles or Jewellery are not permitted.Facial piercings are not permittedTattoos are not permitted
Academy ID cards	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Student ID cards must be worn and visible at all times during the academy day.

The Head of Sixth Form is the ultimate judge of acceptability regarding dress code. The Academy reserves the right to issue further guidance and clarification if it proves necessary to do so.

The Grange Academy reserves the right to send Sixth Form students home without prior notification if they do not abide by the agreed dress code.
