

16-19 Study Requirements

Studying at The Grange

The Academy Day runs from 8.30am to 3.10pm, and your study programme will comprise subject lessons, meetings with your Tutor, supervised study periods, enrichment and unsupervised study periods

Year 12 study programme

For most students, the study programme will include:

- Three Advanced level courses or single BTECs/Applied Diplomas
- The Extended Project Qualification OR the Sports Leaders Course (Enrichment Elective)
- Other Extra-curricular opportunities
- Tutorial programme
- Between 3 and 6 supervised study periods
- Some unsupervised study periods

Year 13 study programme

For most students, the study programme will comprise of:

- Three Advanced level courses or single BTECs/Applied Diplomas
- Conclusion of the Extended Project Qualification (for some)
- Tutorial programme
- Between 3 and 6 supervised study periods
- Some unsupervised study periods

Electives

A key part of our offer in Year 12 is the opportunity for students to attempt the Extended Project which gives them the chance to gain real independence, resilience and maturity. The EPQ is equivalent to half an A level. The other option is the Sports Leader Qualification. This allows students to develop their coaching skills and organize groups of younger students to prepare and participate in competitive sports fixtures.

Other Extra Curricular Opportunities

Sixth formers can get involved in multiple activities and events as part of the whole school council and they can participate in the broader school-wide enrichment programme. They are encouraged to set up and run clubs and societies for younger students. These are optional. Many students choose to take part in societies ranging from Chess to Badminton. We encourage you to get involved in the rich variety of societies, clubs and teams at the Grange.

Tutorial programme

The relationship between students and their tutors are a crucial aspect of how the sixth form is run at the Grange. Students meet with their Tutor every day and time is set aside for individual support, careers guidance and other activities.tutors also support students with making post 18 applications

Study Periods

Each student has up to 3 supervised study periods each week. This is a minimum of three but can be more. These periods can be used at the student's discretion for study, research and extension work. They are required to be completed in the sixth form study room. Beyond these supervised study periods students are expected to use the rest of their 'non-contact' time working and these are all deemed 'unsupervised study periods'. Students should use the Academy's study areas and Library during these periods.
