**Dear Parent or Carer** 

When the National Lockdown ends on 2 December, Hertsmere, Watford and Three Rivers will move into Tier 2. This seems a timely moment for an update on the continuing challenges of Covid for schools.

The year group 'bubbles' at The Grange continue to work well, though we have a slightly larger number of children self-isolating in Years 8 and 9 this week. One thing that I would like to re-emphasise is the importance of wearing a mask in corridors and all communal areas inside the school. I am sorry to report that a minority of children are still failing to do so. We will continue to contact parents but please do reiterate this to your son or daughter. Of course there are one or two children who have valid health exemptions and a doctor's note but they are the only ones to whom an exception can apply. We have noticed that on PE days pupils often leave their masks in their blazer pocket from the day before, so if you could remind your son or daughter to double check on PE days that would be a great help.

It is vital, too, that all pupils travelling to and from school on public transport wear a mask at all times and that everyone goes straight home rather than congregating in groups around shops etc.
